- There are 7 uses of “in the name”

In the name - - -

- **Jesus** – Applied to Jesus' mission
- **Luke 19:38** saying: "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"
- Parallel verses – Matthew 21:9, 23:39; Mark 11:9-10; Luke 13:35; John 12:13
- **John 14:26a** But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name

In the name - - -

- **Worship / Assemble**
- **1 Corinthians 5:4** In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when you are gathered together, along with my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- **Matthew 18:20** For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them."
- **Matthew 24:5; Luke 21:8** – false claims

In the name - - -

- **Prayer**

- **Ephesians 5:20** giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- **James 5:14** Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.

In the name - - -

- **Prayer**

- **John 14:13-14** 13 And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.
- **John 15:16b** that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.
- **John 16:24** Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

In the name - - -

- **Teach / Speak**
- **Acts 4:18** And they called them and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus.
- **Acts 5:40b** they commanded that they should not speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go.
- **James 5:10a** My brethren, take the prophets, who spoke in the name of the Lord

In the name - - -

- **Teach / Speak**
- **Acts 9:27** But Barnabas took him and brought him to the apostles. And he declared to them how he had seen the Lord on the road, and that He had spoken to him, and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the name of Jesus.
- **Acts 9:29a** And he spoke boldly in the name of the Lord Jesus and disputed against the Hellenists

In the name - - -

- **Good works**
- **Matthew 10:41-42** 41 He who receives a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward. And he who receives a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward. 42 And whoever gives one of these little ones only a cup of cold water in the name of a disciple, assuredly, I say to you, he shall by no means lose his reward."

In the name - - -

- **Good works**
- **Acts 3:6** Then Peter said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk."
- **Colossians 3:17** And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

In the name - - -

- **Baptism**

- **Matthew 28:19** Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,
- **Acts 2:38** Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

In the name - - -

- **Baptism**

- **Acts 8:16b** They had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.
- **Acts 10:48** And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord.
- **Acts 19:5** When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

In the name - - -

- **Baptism**
- **1 Corinthians 1:13** Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?
- **Have you been baptized in the name of Jesus Christ?**

In the name - - -

- **Salvation**
- **1 Corinthians 6:11** And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.

In the name - - -

- Phrase = under the direction, control or authority
- **IT IS WHAT WE DO; WHY WE DO IT; WHO GIVES US TO AUTHORITY**
- It is not wrong to publicly explain our authority or source of direction
- It is not required to use the phrase

In the name - - -

- **Colossians 3:17** And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.
