#### Jesus walked on water

- 3 Passages
  - Matthew 14:22-36
  - Mark 6:45-56
  - John 6:16-24
- Basic Facts Fed 5,000; crowd wants to make Him king; Send apostles across the Sea of Galilee; Jesus sends crowd away; Goes into mountain to pray; storm on sea

#### Jesus walked on water

- Apostles rowed until 4<sup>th</sup> watch (3-6 am)
- Only rowed 3 miles
- Jesus comes walking on the water
- They cry out in fear
- Peter walks on water
- Jesus gets in boat and calms the storm
- They arrive

### Study all 3 accounts

- ONLY MATTEW Peter walks on water Matthew 14:29-31

- Walking on water is not natural
- Miracle John 20:30, 31 30 And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; 31 but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.
- Christian life goes against the norm

- Walking on water requires more than desire, it requires help
- Matthew 14:29-30 29 So He said, "Come." And when Peter had come down out of the boat, he walked on the water to go to Jesus. 30 But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, "Lord, save me!"
- Some seed among the thorns (Matthew 13)
- Caution: Cares of this world distract

- Psalm 69:2-3 2 I sink in deep mire, Where there is no standing; I have come into deep waters, Where the floods overflow me. 3 I am weary with my crying; My throat is dry; My eyes fail while I wait for my God.
